Autism in English-language Fiction Anita Zupanc (slovenistka), Jason Blake, 2013 In considering autism in fiction, this diploma thesis first presents the threetypes of autistic spectrum disorders: classic autism, Asperger syndrome, and Pervasive Developmental Disorder - Not Otherwise Specified (PDD-NOS). Being diagnosed with classic autism means that the person has all three core features of the disorder: impairment of reciprocal social interaction (not wishing and not being able to attend social interaction), impairment of communication (not being able to understand verbal and/or non-verbal communication), and narrow interests and repetitive activities (following strict routines, having obsessions, focusing on detail). People with Aspergersyndrome are diagnosed later because they usually have no language impairments and are high-functioning (i.e. have high IQs). The last group is formed by people who do not display all symptoms of autism or Asperger syndrome and whose symptoms are milder. The thesis then moves on to explaining the history of researching the causes of autism: from cold mothers, measles, mumps, and rubella vaccine, to thimerosal (a derivate of mercury). The jury is still out on what exactly the cause of autism is. It seems that there is a certain genetic predisposition that together with other factors results in autism. Because of many theories that developed about autism from the beginning of the 20th century, because people with autism wereso different, and because of the film Rain Man, presenting and autistic savant (a person with one or two extraordinary cognitive abilities like special mathematical talents), autistic characters were also portrayed in fiction. The thesis presents seven books; one autistic or autistic-like character is presented in each. Three characters are main

characters: Lou Arrendale in Speed of Dark, Crake in Oryx and Crake, and Christopher Boone in The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time. The rest of the characters are minor ones: Boo Radley in To Kill a Mockingbird, Manfred in Martian Time Slip, Randall in Family Pictures, and Shep in By the Light of the Moon.
