To make it easier to understand this work I've modernized the language, simplified certain sayings, shortened some sentences, divided some long paragraphs, and researched more into particular spirits and their actions so that you understand better what King James means in certain passages. (My notes are distinguished from the main work.) Since this document was written in archaic English and Scottish languages, it took me a while to understand some sentences and phrases, but I hope that I've translated everything correctly; when I really didn't understand what was meant by some phrase (which happened a few times), I simply left the phrase as it was, so that not to accidentally change the meaning.
