This study considers this analogy from the opposite perspective: authors attempting to structure words using musical forms and techniques. After these three larger analyses, Shockley discusses two quite recent brief novels, William Gaddis' novella *Agap?gape* and David Markson's *This is not a novel*, proposing that each of these confounding texts coheres elegantly when viewed as a musically-structured work. From the perspective of a composer, Shockley offers the reader fresh tools for approaching these dense and often daunting texts.
