The Reality of Women in the Universe of the Ancient Novel María Paz López Martínez, Carlos Sánchez-Moreno Ellart, Ana Belén Zaera García, 2023-12-01 This volume gathers chapters related to the condition of women in the ancient novel. To broaden the perspective, it integrates not only papers dealing with the Greek and Roman novel as a literary genre in its own right, but also as a historical document involving aspects as diverse as history, archaeology, sociology and the history of law. The twenty-six contributions in this volume have been divided into thematic blocks, based on the different approaches that the authors have adopted to tackle the subject. The first block is about realia – the reality in which the fiction has been conceived. The second block focuses on the legal problems that can be deduced from the plots of the novels. The third block encompasses deals with the Greek and Roman novel from the point of view of classical philology, literary criticism and literary theory, with chapters dedicated to the tradition of the ancient novel, both in our most immediate cultural area (Middle Ages, Spanish Golden Age) and in other contexts, whether Indo-European (India, Persia) or of a different origin.

Collected Papers of Franco Montanari Franco Montanari, 2023-10-24 Volume I of Franco Montanari's *Kleine Schriften* comprises some 66 papers on ancient scholarship, a topic which he decisively helped establishing as an extremely important field of study; they include general surveys of Alexandrian and Pergamene philology, major contributions to ancient Homeric scholarship (with a particular emphasis on Aristarchus), ancient scholarship on Hesiod and Aeschylus, as well as an important number of editions and notes on papyrological scholarly texts. Volume II

consists of 42 contributions to Homer's Iliad and Odyssey, Pindar, Aeschylus, Herodotus, Euripides, the Athenaion Politeia, Lucian, Nonnus, philosophical papyri, the reception of antiquity and portraits of contemporary scholars.

Ai paesaggi marini dell'avventura e delle tempeste succedono gli angoli silenti di una piccola isola ionia, con i suoi porti, le rocce, le grotte, i sentieri sassosi che portano alla reggia, teatro del dramma. Guidato da Atena, "dea dell'intelligenza e della forza", cioè guidato dall'ispirazione interiore, Odisseo riconquista i valori positivi creati dal l'Iliade - in primo luogo la libertà del volere di fronte al destino - e fa di se stesso un nuovo tipo di uomo, artefice e modello di modernità. Intorno a lui, a Itaca, come nel vasto mondo del Mediterraneo arcaico, uomini e donne, umili e potenti, sono ritratti nella ricerca inesausta della felicità e della giustizia, nonostante le delusioni e le difficoltà della vita. Quintus Smyrnaeus: Transforming Homer in Second Sophistic Epic Manuel Baumbach, Silvio Bär, 2012-02-14 The "Events after Homer", described by Quintus Smyrnaeus in the third century AD in his Greek epic Posthomerica, are an attempt to bridge the gap between the Iliad and the Odyssey, and to combine the various scattered reports of the battle for Troy into a single tale: the fate of Achilles, Ajax, Paris and the Amazon Penthesileia, the intervention of Neoptolemos and the story from the Trojan horse to the destruction of the city. The volume presented here summarizes the results of the first international conference on Quintus Smyrnaeus.

L'Odissea com'è: Canti XIII-XXIV Mario Zambarbieri, 2002 Questo libro interpreta l'Odissea come una grande opera d'arte «unitaria», che solo attraverso un lungo processo compositivo ha raggiunto la forma finale e una spiccata originalità rispetto al modello. La discussione dei problemi è facilitata da un'introduzione storica sugli studi odisseici, alla quale corrisponde, alla fine dell'opera, una sintesi sui rapporti tra poema e storia, sulla composizione, i personaggi, la fortuna e la poesia dell'Odissea. Ciascun canto è studiato in tre momenti, lettura, analisi, valutazioni critiche. Il testo viene quasi integralmente tradotto in forma chiara e moderna, e interpretato sulla base di una ricognizione ad ampio raggio della filologia omerica, dai tempi di Hermann ai nostri giorni; nelle conclusioni si definisce ogni volta il valore poetico del canto e, progressivamente, delle singole tètredi di cui è idealmente composto il poema. Per amore di autenticità si cerca sempre di

risalire alle fonti, documentando con chiarezza in brevi citazioni l'origine e il valore delle idee e delle notizie. Sotto questo aspetto, il libro fa la storia dell'interpretazione, perché mette in luce il contributo originale degli studiosi e delle dottrine alla comprensione della poesia omerica. La complessità dell'Odissea, «forma aperta» ad accogliere ogni aspetto della civiltà arcaica, richiede la cooperazione di diverse discipline e competenze specifiche. Sotto il profilo bibliografico, il libro presenta una selezione delle opere più geniali e più utili, nel campo di una produzione quasi sterminata. Gli indici analitici agevolano l'uso dei due volumi anche per una consultazione estemporanea.

Peirce a sostenere che siamo spinti a produrre pensiero soprattutto quando qualcosa ci frastorna, e lo facciamo per ritrovare l'equilibrio perduto, le incombenze di una madre dovrebbero risultare le più congeniali alla creatività della mente. Ma per la tradizione filosofica occidentale «cuore di mamma» non si concilia affatto con «testa di mamma», anzi sembra precluderle addirittura la possibilità. Dove si muovono le viscere, non c'è posto per l'astrazione. Maneggiando con sapiente garbo e al tempo stesso con giudizio saettante dottrine, mitologie, teologemi, Francesca Rigotti capovolge tale luogo comune: le cure domestiche attivano un sensorio estetico e morale che, lungi dall'ostacolare la riflessione, offre un prezioso vantaggio speculativo. Una prospettiva «practicalista» che ha radici nell'esperienza di Rigotti filosofa e madre di quattro figli, arruola figure esemplari – come la prolificissima G. E. M. Anscombe, studiosa di Wittgenstein – e rifà all'inverso il cammino di una delle metafore più comuni, quella della concezione e del parto intellettuali. Esclusi dalla procreazione carnale, i filosofi se ne sono appropriati in modo traslato, e ne hanno coniato una versione eroica e spiritualizzata che ha finito per obliterare la figura della madre. È venuto il momento di restituirle la centralità all'interno delle «cose prime». Francesca Rigotti insegna Concetti e metafore della politica presso la Facoltà di Scienze della comunicazione dell'Università della Svizzera italiana di
