The Prairie Trilogy Willa Cather, 2017-09-30 O Pioneers! is a 1913 novel by American author Willa Cather, written while she was living in New York. In *Flavia and Her Artists*, a young woman named Imogen goes to visit her friend Flavia, who is a patron of artists.
