selected facts about Albert Camus. Albert Camus was born in the small coastal town of Mondovi, Algeria, in 1913. Camus married in 1934 at age 21. His wife, Simone Hie, was the daughter of a wealthy ophthalmologist. She was also a morphine addict, and the marriage dissolved amidst mutual infidelities after only two years. In 1934, he joined the Communist Party in reaction to the rise of fascism in Europe. Camus was expelled from the Communist Party for his support of Algerian nationalism. President George W. Bush reportedly read *The Stranger* while on vacation in 2006. Albert Camus preferred to write while standing (as did Ernest Hemingway, Vladimir Nabokov, and Virginia Woolf). The stripped-down prose style of *The Stranger* was influenced by American writers Ernest Hemingway, John Dos Passos, and William Faulkner. Camus also said that James M. Cain's crime novel *The Postman Always Rings Twice* provided much inspiration. Albert Camus won the Nobel Prize for Literature in 1957. The prize was awarded largely for his extended essay *Reflections on the Guillotine*, which argued against capital punishment. Albert Camus was the first African-born writer to receive the award. However, even on this level, it has an irony about it, a sense of laughing at itself and at Dylan’s Mr Jones, who knows something is going on but just not what it is, and then, by extension, all of us who have awakened to the fact that the studied Western world doesn’t make sense, all of us who struggle to find meaning in the nonsense images, characters, and happenings in the song, and perhaps, coming to a conclusion that the nonsense is the sense.
