Resulta que en Ulthar vivía una pareja de ancianos campesinos que se divertían atrapando y asesinando gatos de maneras extrañas, sin saber que destino que les esperaba. Escrito en 1920 por H.P. Lovecraft, *Los gatos de Ulthar* es uno de los cuentos más populares del reconocido escritor. Howard Phillips Lovecraft (1890-1937), más conocido como H.P. Lovecraft, fue un escritor estadounidense, autor de novelas y relatos cortos de terror y ciencia ficción. Conocido por enfocarse en el género llamado horror cósmico, su obra mezcla el terror sobrenatural con elementos de ciencia ficción, como otras dimensiones, viajes en el tiempo y extraterrestres. Autor de célebres cuentos como *Dagón* (1917), *La tumba* (1917), *Celefais* (1920) o *La decisión de Randolph Carter* (1919). Su obra más importante llamada *Los mitos de Cthulhu* incluye famosos relatos como *La Ciudad Sin Nombre* (1921), *El Ceremonial* (1923) o *La Llamada De Cthulhu* (1926).

El primero narra el encuentro con una entidad extraterrestre; el segundo es una historia evocadora y onírica sobre el poder de la música. Finalmente, se incluyen dos de las historias más emblemáticas de Lovecraft, donde salen a la luz sus demonios internos: «El extraño» y «Las ratas de las paredes». Los relatos de Lovecraft impregnados de un «terror cósmico» inquietante nos revelan aspectos secretos del universo que nunca

hubiéramos imaginado que existieran. Si el lector experimenta un escalofrío al leerlos, y si su corazón no puede soportar la impresión, siempre puede cerrar el libro...
