Nursing Considerations for Post-traumatic Amnesia After a Traumatic Brain Injury Hannah Grant, 2022 A period known as post-traumatic amnesia (PTA) often follows a traumatic brain injury (TBI). PTA is characterized by anterograde and retrograde amnesia, confusion, disorientation, and agitation. The duration and severity of PTA is a key indicator of the long-term prognosis after a TBI, so proper assessment and nursing care of a PTA patient is crucial. TBIs range from mild to severe, but primarily affect the fronto-temporal lobes. In PTA, both neural lesions and white matter damage within the parahippocampal region can cause PTA. A nurse must perform a thorough assessment of a TBI patient, but, since PTA is a key indicator of a TBI, a nurse must be familiar with the PTA assessment scales, particularly when comparing the Westmead Post-Traumatic Amnesia Scale (WPTAS) and the Galveston Orientation and Amnesia Test (GOAT). Finally, multi-disciplinary care of a TBI patient within PTA patient must include evidence-based pharmacological and nonpharmacological treatments, nursing considerations, nutritional considerations, physical and occupational therapy, and psychosocial implications.

Estimation of Post-traumatic Amnesia in Emergency Department Attendees Presenting with Head Injury Louise Richards, 2011 Objectives: To explore whether a semi-structured post-traumatic amnesia (PTA) assessment interview (PTA-I) provides a practicable but equivalent estimation of PTA in patients attending the Emergency Department (ED) with head injury (HI) compared to the established Westmead PTA Scale Revised (R-WPTAS). Procedure: PTA was assessed using the R-WPTAS (includes a visual memory component) and the PTA-I (includes retrospective and verbal memory components), in

patients attending an ED with (n=30) or without (n= 30) HI. Outcome measures were the Post-concussion Syndrome Checklist (PCSC) and the Glasgow Coma Scale (GCS). McNemar's Tests and Chi-square analyses were used to determine the results. Results: The verbal memory component overestimated PTA in the control group by 24 %. Overall, the PTA-I did not discriminate between HI and control participants. However the retrospective PTA assessment embedded within the PTA-I did, with 100 % accuracy. Conclusions: The use of a verbal memory component to assess PTA in the ED is not supported by the results of this study. A retrospective PTA assessment appears to allow more accurate decision making regarding the admission criteria used in the ED and has advantages over the R-WPTAS: fewer test materials and no repeat assessments required to achieve an estimate of PTA duration.
