Interestingly, the concept for the trilogy emerged in a discussion with Lewis's friend J.R.R. Tolkien; the conversation concluded with an agreement for Lewis to write a space travel story and Tolkien a time travel one. Tolkien never completed The Lost Road, but Lewis's space trilogy came to fruition. Interestingly, the character of Elwin Ransom is at least partially based on Tolkien himself, by his own admission in his letters.
