O cérebro autista Temple Grandin, 2015-08-21 Quando Temple Grandin nasceu, em 1947, o autismo acabara de ser classificado como tal. Hoje, estima-se que 70 milhões de pessoas sejam portadoras do transtorno do espectro autista - cerca de 1% da população mundial -, o que faz com que ele seja cada vez mais conhecido e discutido. Os estudos da área também se transformaram nos últimos anos: passaram da psicologia à neurologia e à genética, e, graças a novas pesquisas revolucionárias sobre as causas e tratamento, há cada vez mais esperança. Por meio da observação de casos que vão desde os Aspies do Vale do Silício até uma criança não verbal, Grandin compreende o real significado da palavra espectro, o que faz deste livro uma leitura essencial sobre o assunto.
