The combination of a voice, treaty, and truth would be ideal - rather than merely the recognition of those concepts in isolation. Thomas Mayor has explained the need for an Indigenous Voice. He reflects: The Voice is the key step forward. Truth-telling alone does not produce solutions. We do. And the truth is justification for the solutions we seek and deserve. To use the truth to get meaningful, lasting treaties, and to affect the legislation and policies that have so fatally failed us, we must have a Collective Voice to the Federal Parliament in Canberra. Our Elders have called for a Voice for generations. We direly need representatives that we choose, who are accountable to us - not the parliament, a corporate sponsor or the media. The time has come for this proposal. We must not take "no" for an answer. The line has been drawn in the red sand at Uluru. There remain many outstanding issues of public policy in respect of Indigenous rights and Indigenous intellectual property. It is worth outlining a number of areas, worthy of further law reform and development.
