Henry David Thoreau (born David Henry Thoreau) is a philosopher, naturalist and American poet, born July 12, 1817 in Concord (Massachusetts), where he died May 6, 1862. His masterpiece, Walden, or Life in the woods, is a reflection on the economy, nature and the simple life lived apart from society, written during a retreat in a cabin he had built on the edge of a lake. His essay Civil Disobedience, reflecting a personal opposition to the slave of the time authorities inspired collective action by Gandhi and Martin Luther King Jr. against racial segregation.
